


## How to Make My course Visible to Students

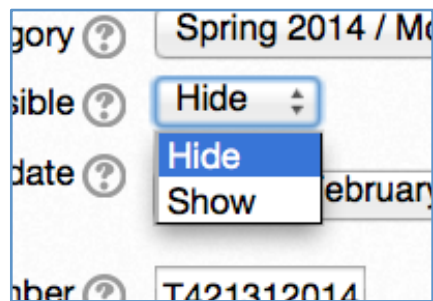
1. Login to Moodle and go to the course you want to open for students.
2. Once in the course go to the **Administration Bar** on the Left side of the screen and click on **Edit Settings**.
3. On the course settings you will see a General Area .




